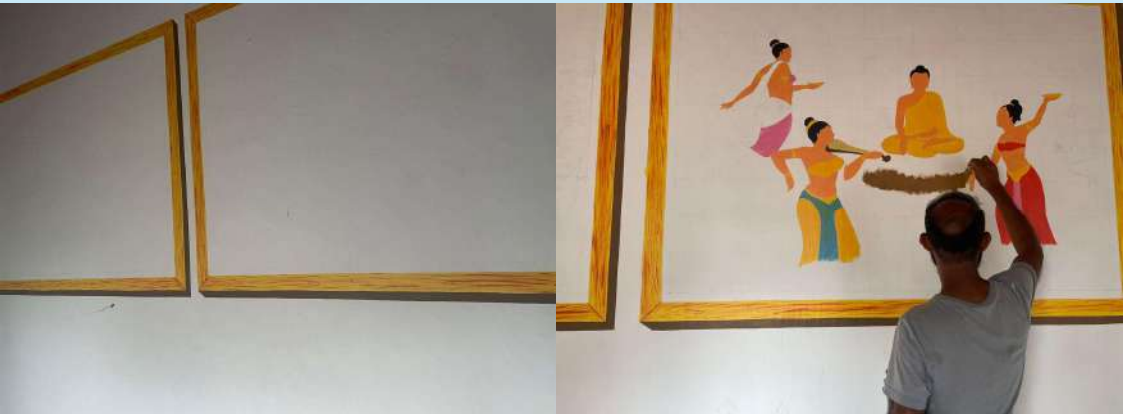

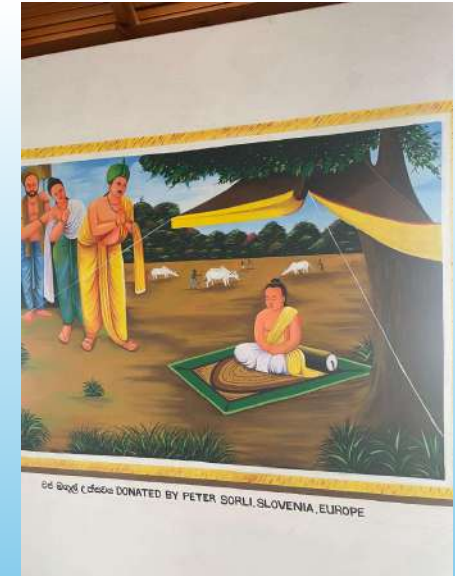

- Hygiene items and sanitary items for elder people

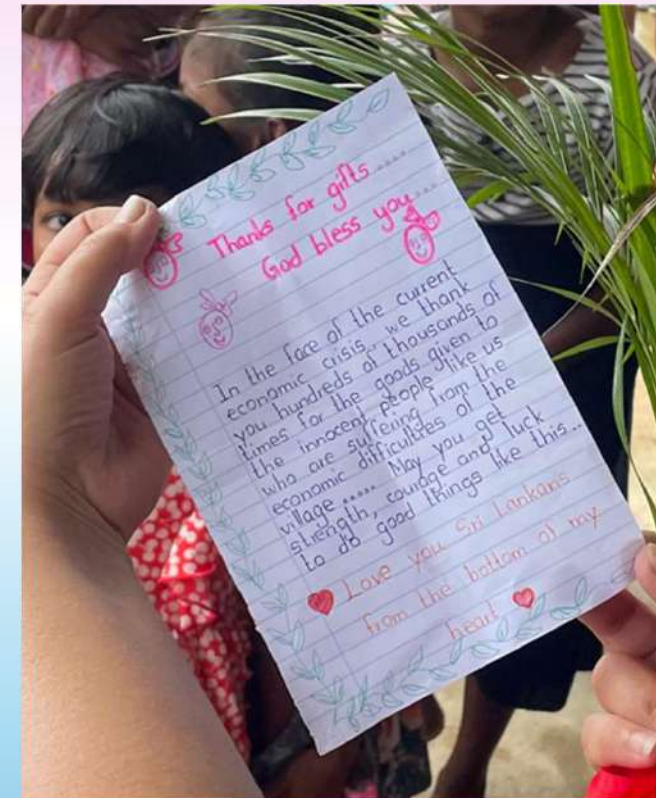
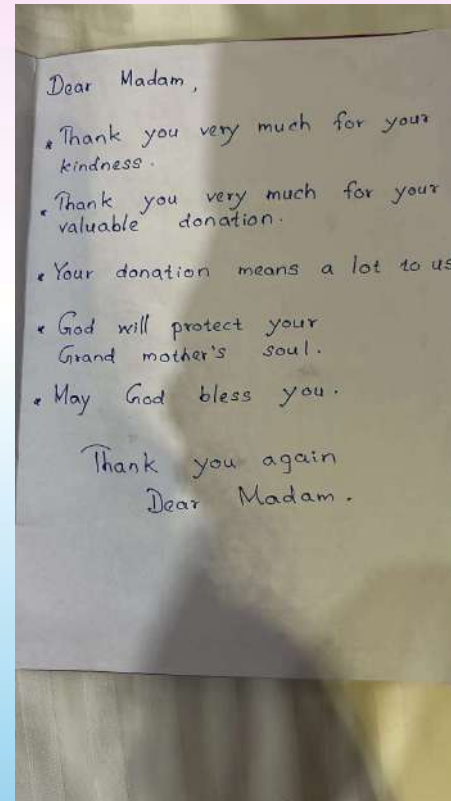
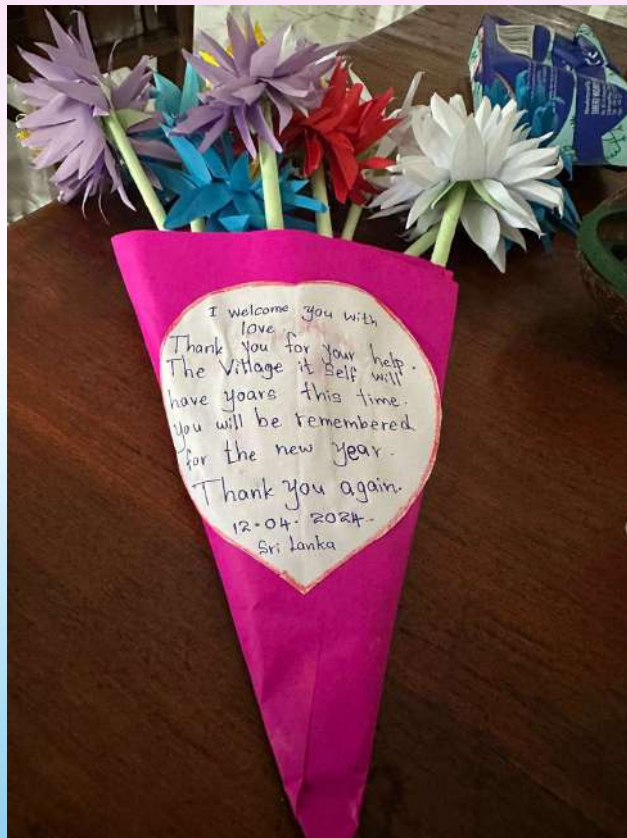
